Ownership - Co-ownership of a Patent

In the recent case of *Stanelco Fibre Optics Ltd v* Biopress Technology Ltd [2004], the courts ruled on the issues of patent ownership, joint ownership and clarified the test in joint ownership for identifying the actual deviser of the inventive concept More.

International Trade Mark Applications under the Madrid Protocol - European Community acceded to the Madrid Protocol

The European Community ('EC') acceded to the Madrid Protocol ('Protocol') earlier this year providing a one-stop registration system for European Union (EU) member countries to the Protocol. The Protocol offers UK trade mark owners the possibility of having their trade mark protected in several countries by simply filing an International application directly with the UK Patents Office More.

Landmark Patent decision In Biotech Case - What is the extent of protection conferred by a patent? In a recent Landmark case, Kirin-Amgen Inc and others v Hoechst Marion Roussel Ltd (HL) [2004], the House of Lords has finally laid down that the legal test regarding the proper construction of the claims of a patent More.
